In 2013 Brill celebrates its 330th anniversary as academic publisher, making Brill the oldest existing publishing house in the Netherlands, and one of the oldest in the world. Its history goes back to 17 May 1683, when Jordaan Luchtmans established himself as a bookseller in Leiden. Five generations of the Luchtmans family served as "Printers to the University" until 1848, when Evert Jan Brill took over the firm, giving it his own name.
